

Today, at Specialized Medical Hospital, Mansoura University, Egypt, under the patronages of Professor Dr. Hazem Hakim, the hospital director, and the deputy directors, Dr. Ahmed Saeed and Dr. Samar Moussa, and with the supervision and coordination of Fatma Shafeq, the nursing manager, for the third year a celebration of International Pressure Ulcer Prevention Day was held. The activities began with health education sessions for outpatients, their families, and patient companions in the inpatient wards, as an external community with a presentation by Fatma Shafeq, General Supervisor of the Skin and Pressure Ulcers Care Team on the importance of the topic and methods of prevention. A translated video from the European Advisory panel on Pressure Ulcer Prevention was shown, and translated algorithm were provided in printed form. Then Nesma Al-Arabi, Member of the Skin Care Team provided education on how to care for pressure ulcers when they occur.

The second part of the event consisted of lectures to the medical team. These included a lecture on pressure ulcers, their assessment, and initial care by Dr. Doaa Agiz, Assistant Lecturer of Geriatric Medicine. The second lecture, presented by Dr. Ahmed Ali, Assistant Lecturer of Critical Care Medicine addressed the consequences of hospital acquired pressure ulcers and how to avoid them, and a final lecture by Fatma shafeq, Master Degree in Critical Care Nursing on preventing pressure ulcers using care bundle aligning with the international guidelines for prevention (2025).
