Clinical

I am a Clinical Nurse Specialist (ICLS) at the Stomatherapy, Wound and Healing Centre of Lausanne University Hospital in Switzerland. My strong specialisation in wound care allows me to provide follow-up and management for patients needing specialised consultations. With a Master of Science as the foundation of my expertise, I strive to bring significant added value to the care of individuals suffering from complex wounds.

Clinical Leadership and Evidence-Based Practice

I provide clinical support and supervision to nursing staff, applying Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) principles to ensure high-quality patient care and promote the integration of current evidence into clinical decision-making and supports the continuous development of professional competencies.

Scientific research

I obtained my Master's degree in 2022 at the University of Galway, Ireland, by conducting a research on Knowledge, attitudes and practices of skin tears prevention and management among nurses in French-speaking Switzerland. The recognition of my expertise has gradually led me to become engaged in research over the years.

Clinical Reasoning and Team Development

I mobilize and leverage team members' knowledge and expertise to enhance collective clinical practice.
